

Mother Teresa Bara Jersey

With short sleeves and cozy ribbing around the body, this extra layer of warmth knits up quickly.

Use worsted weight machine washable yarn- acrylic, wool, or wool blend. Choose something soft.

Needles size US 7, or size you need to make gauge of 18 - 20 stitches to 4 inches/10 cm in stockinette stitch.

Garment is worked flat in one piece starting at the bottom. Work up to the shoulders, and back down again on the other side. After folding in half, it is seamed along the sides.

Sizes on pattern below are for gauge of 20 sts /4". At gauge of 18 sts / 4", it will knit up a little looser, but will still fit some little one, so don't worry too much about gauge.

Feeling creative? Add some lace, cables, colorwork or embroidery as you wish.

Follow the instructions in the column under the chosen size.

11	Work in k2 x p2 rib for same number of rows as worked in line 6.

13	For back, work the same number of rows in stockinette stitch as worked for front .											
14	Work in k2 x p2 ribbing for the same number of rows as worked for front bottom edge.											
15	Bind off in rib and sew up sides. Darn in ends.
