

HISTORY OF THE NATIONAL QUILT FESTIVALS

1986 (July) Swakopmund

The Sondag-Sonntags-Sunday Republik ein Newspaper, South West Africa (now Namibia) advertised the Quilt Festival of 1986 as a “first of its kind” exhibition hosted by the Swakopmund Quilters’ Corner under the leadership of Valmai Osborn.

Visitors from South Africa did not need passports and so many attended this exhibition/festival.

Workshops and lectures were presented by Maretha Fourie, Barbara Malan, Shirly Wittridge, Dianne Joubert, Marie Smit and Pam Munro. These workshops and/or lectures focused on Traditional patchwork, Candle wicking, Shadow Trapunto, Jacket making, Reverse appliques and Seminole patchwork. Workshops also catered for real beginners.

The exhibition was officially opened by Mr Jorg Henrichsen, the mayor of Swakopmund and attendees were treated to a fashion show of “patchwork clothing” by Diane Joubert from Empangeni.

COMMENTS: Entries: 300 entries, 21 theme quilts. Only theme was judged, using the points system: Gen appearance 25, design 50, workmanship 25.

The first National Quilt Festival was held 5th-9th April 1988 at Pinelands High School, in Pinelands, Cape Town. The event was organized and hosted by a group of Pinelands quilters. They had read about similar events happening in America and as none of them were able to go there, they decided to try out the concept in Cape Town.

The people involved in organizing the Festival included Hazelmay Duncan, Jenny Hermans, Lynn Macintosh, Sue Andrews, Sheila O'Neill and her husband Bernard, Patsy Tyler, Rosalind Odendaal and Carol Davis. Shirley Wittridge was initially involved but withdrew. The event was presented in collaboration with Education and Culture in Service of the Community.

In Cape Town and around South Africa in that year there were various celebrations of the 500th Anniversary of the rounding of the Cape by Bartholomew Dias, the Portuguese explorer (landing in Mossel Bay to collect water for his vessels in 1488). The Festival had a theme competition which commemorated this - Diaz competition. The participants were required to make a wall-hanging depicting some aspect or connection to this historic event. There were 21 entries, 7 of which were later donated to the Dias Museum in Mossel Bay and are on display there.

First prize winner was Netta Schutte from Potchefstroom, and other winners were Odette Tolksdorf (2nd) Shirley Wittridge (3rd) and Beryl Smith (4th). The Judges were Suzette Ehlers, Maureen van Dam, Colin Thompson (headmaster of Pinelands High School) and Carina du Toit from the Dept of Education and Culture.

The exhibition was opened by the late Adele Searle. The competition prizes were given out as well as a Viewer's choice ribbon which went to Suzette Ehlers for an appliqué quilt "My New Antique Quilt", There was a fashion show of patchwork clothing.

Approximately 3000 people attended and viewed the exhibition and a total of 166 people attended the courses which were held, filling a total of 514 places.

The teachers were Sue Andrews, Lesley Delport, Hazelmay Duncan, Sandy Ingle, Celia de Villiers-Lossgott, Barbara Malan, Marie Peacey, Dorothy Watson, Shirley Wittridge and Rosalind Odendaal. Classes included Mola, candewicking, Shadow appliqué, pattern analysis, Speed piecing, colour, 3D appliqué, stained glass, Porcella jackets and contemporary quilts.

COMMENTS: Scorecard used: Gen Impact 10, Design 50, Workmanship 40.

The 3rd SA National Quilt Festival was held at the Sand du Plessis Theatre in Bloemfontein from 5th – 8th September 1989. The theme was "Roses". All the printed matter was available in Afrikaans only!

The judging method used was a Scorecard awarding points as follows: General Impact = 10 points; Design = 50 points and Workmanship = 40 points. The score card was divided as follows: (With thanks to Mari Strydom)

- **General Impact (10 Marks)**
 - Acceptable Appearance with a special quality = 6 marks
Excellent = 3 marks, Good = 2 marks and Can improve = 1 mark
 - Purposeful approach to the theme = 4 marks
Excellent = 4 marks, Good = 2 marks and Can improve = 1 mark
- **Design (50 marks)**
 - Choice and use of design for top and borders = 13 marks
 - Is the design acceptable and in proportion?
 - Does it complement the colours used?
Excellent = 13 marks, Good = 10 marks and Can improve = 5 marks
 - Choice and use of the quilting motif = 10 marks
 - Does it decorate the surface of the quilt with a motif that enhances the general appearance?
Excellent = 10 marks, Good = 8 marks and Can improve = 3 marks
 - Choice and use of colour = 12 marks

- Does the harmony of the colors give movement to the design?
 - Do the colours used make the quilt interesting?
Excellent = 12, Good = 10 and Can improve = 5
 - Originality of the design = 15 marks
 - Is it new and stimulating?
Excellent = 15 marks, Good is 12 marks and Can improve = 7 marks
 - **Workmanship (40 marks)**
 - Construction of the top = 20 marks
 - Is the method of construction accurate for e.g. sharp points, curves etc?
Excellent = 20marks, Good =5 marks and Can improve = 10 marks
 - Quilting techniques = 15 marks
 - Does the quilting enhance the design?
Excellent = 15marks. Good = 12 marks and Can improve – 7 marks
 - Correct and appropriate finishing of edges = 4 marks
 - Has the quilt been finished off correctly?
Excellent = 4 marks, Good = 3 marks and Can improve = 1 mark
 - Backing = 1 mark
 - Is the backing neat without any slovenly stitches and marks that deface the quilt?
Excellent = 1 mark, Good = 0 marks and Can improve = 0 marks
- Commentary could also be added by the judges at the end of score sheet.

Prizes included a Bernina 1030 machine for the Best Theme quilt, an Elna F3 over locker, Singer and Pfaff sewing machines, Jewellery (R500), Furniture (R300) and other gift vouchers and cash prizes.

The Festival was opened by the wife of the Administrator of the Orange Free State and prizes were presented at the Award Ceremony Dinner. The fee for entering a quilt was R10 for the first entry and R5 for each subsequent entry. The Festival ran for four days and the workshops offered changed a lot between then and the present. Workshops seemed to be quite traditional while nowadays many fibre art, dyeing and newer design techniques are taught.

All of the teachers were local (South African) and fees for the workshops were set at R20 or R40 per person, depending on who the teacher was.

The Bloemfontein Guild organised the 3rd National Festival and they decided to rename themselves the 'Oranje Guild' as they hoped to attract quilters from the whole of Orange Free State.

The founding meeting of SAQG took place Wednesday, 6 September 1989, during the lunch break from 12:30-13:30. Mrs Marie Grimbeek from the Bloemfontein Guild welcomed everybody and Mrs. Maretha Fourie from the Golden Rand Guild, acted as the coordinator for this meeting. A unanimous decision was reached for the founding of a National Guild to look after the quilters' interests and a name was subsequently decided upon – The South African Quilters' Guild which had the sole purpose of promoting quilt making. It was also agreed upon that SAQG would consist of different regional guilds and not individual members. Each of these guilds would be represented by one or two members from each guild. They decided on the certain regions. These regions then selected a representative for the National Quilters Guild during lunch.

These representatives met on Thursday, 7 September 1989 to discuss the first functions of SAQG.

Rosalie Dace was elected first chairperson, Maretha Fourie took down the minutes and Dee Oxborrow was appointed as the first secretary. No constitution was drafted but it was decided upon that it would be done at the next General Meeting in July 1990. A donation of R1 per member was suggested as a membership fee.
